Bold grassy aromas, as well as wet slate and petrol, are concentrated and exciting. On the palate, more fruit comes through, led by white grapefruit and gooseberry. The wine ripples with acidity for a delightful mouthfeel, leading into a long, savory finish. Subtle petrol notes seem dying to break free, so this one may do well with a little time.
