The 2021 Pouilly-Fuissé Clos des Prouges might not be a Premier Cru, but it is treated like one by the winemaking team.

Nevertheless, it doesn't fully engage on the nose as much as the Clos de Jeanne. It's tightly knit and stoic at the moment. The palate is better with fine weight. It's fresh and malic in style, with a bright Granny Smith and yellow plum-infused finish. The 2021 ends on a high note
